Not Hazardous

None required at normal temperature. In case of fumes produced during burning, remove person to fresh air.

Ingestion:

Unlikely route of exposure.

Flush eyes with water. Hold eyelids open while washing.

Unusual Fire and Explosion Hazardous:

May produce irritating vapours, smoke and toxic decomposition products. Foam can emit combustible gases making flashback possible.

Fire Extinguishing Media:

Water (Spray or Fog), Foam, Dry Chemical.

Use self-contained breathing apparatus.

Guard against smoldering re-ignition.

Recommend that material be divided into small enough pieces for complete cooling.

Conditions of Flammability:

Can be made to burn if in persistent contact with source of ignition.

EG. Open Flame.

Section VI. Accidental Release Measures

Breathing apparatus for fire only.

Dilute (substance may be washed to drain with a lot of water). Restrict access to area.

Remove sources of heat and flame.

Spill or leak:

Collect material for re-use or disposal.

Store in dry ventilated area.

Occupational Exposure Limits:
